**CONDITIONS OF INTENSIVE SUPERVISION**

1. You shall not violate any municipal, state or federal law during supervision.
2. You shall maintain a permanent residence and shall not move from that residence without prior consent of your ISP officer.
3. You shall not leave Boulder County unless given written permission by your ISP officer.
4. You shall allow the ISP officer to make either scheduled or unscheduled contacts at your place of employment, residence or other locations, and respond to all reasonable requests by the ISP officer.
5. You shall seek or maintain lawful employment in order to pay all program costs, Court costs and restitution, and to support you and your dependents. You shall not terminate employment without permission of your ISP officer, nor be terminated by your employer with cause. If unemployed, you shall complete a Job Seeks skills course, actively seek employment on a daily basis, accurately maintain the employment contact log and make at least three employer contacts each day.
6. You shall not possess any firearms, explosive or other destructive device nor any other dangerous weapons.
7. You shall not consume alcohol, nor use or possess any controlled substance without a lawful prescription.
8. You shall obtain counseling and/or treatment for drug abuse, alcohol abuse, or a mental condition, and shall remain in a specified residential facility if necessary for that purpose, as required by the court or your ISP officer.
9. You shall report, by telephone to the Adult Probation Department once each day and leave your name.
10. You will not frequent any areas nor associate with any persons as designated by the ISP officer.
11. You will comply with any other conditions required by the Court or by the ISP officer.
